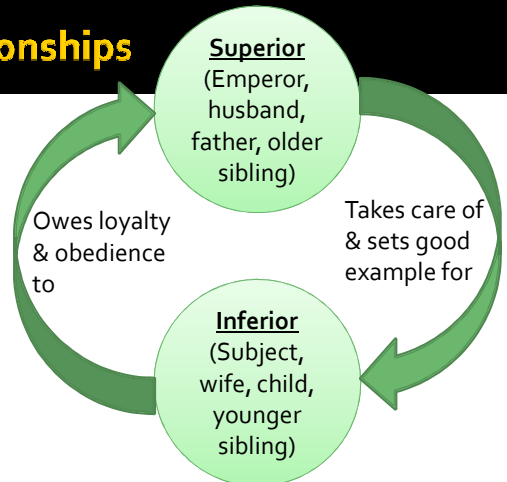

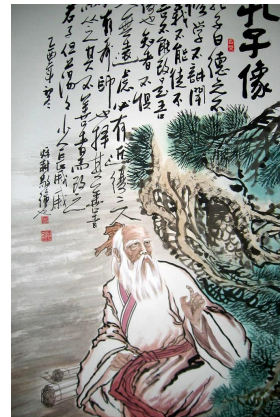


## What do you know/remember?

Confucian Teaching	Effect on China
Education as a way to achieve success in life	-Efficient, well-trained officials in gov't -Civil Service Exams
"Code of conduct" for relationships between people	-Respect for authority figures (emperor, parents, elders, etc.)
